



PRINCE2® Practitioner Training with Foundation and Practitioner Examinations



PRINCE®, which stands for **PR**ojects **IN** Controlled Environments, is a project management method covering the organisation, management and control of projects. It is a process-based approach for project management providing an easily tailored and scalable method for the management of all types of projects. Each process is defined with its key inputs and outputs together with the specific objective to be achieved and activities to be carried out.

PRINCE2 is a structured method providing organisations with a standard approach to the management of projects. The method embodies proven and established best-practice in project management. It is widely recognised and understood, and so provides a common language for all participants in the projects.

PRINCE2 provides benefits to the organisation, as well as the managers and directors of the project, through the controllable use of resources and the ability to manage business and project risk more effectively.

Overview: This highly interactive course will be based upon the 2009 refresh version of PRINCE2 and will cover principles, Processes and themes that comprise the methodology. The course will also cover the appropriate application of PRINCE2 in different size of projects and the embedding of PRINCE2.
